Dear Residents and Family Members:

We wanted to share information with you regarding promising news about the coming COVID-19 vaccine. Though widely covered in the media, information and details about the vaccine, timelines and availability has been confusing.

Spectrum Retirement Communities has been working closely with CVS/Omnicare, our national pharmacy provider, for the past three months preparing for the availability of a COVID-19 vaccine. CVS/Omnicare is one of only two national pharmacy providers selected by the federal government to distribute the vaccine and offer vaccination clinics nationwide.

Our partnership with CVS/Omnicare is critical in providing access to the vaccine for our residents and team members as quickly as possible after distribution begins. We will be providing scheduled COVID-19 vaccination clinics in all Spectrum communities. The vaccine will be provided free of charge for all residents.

On December 2, 2020, the Centers for Disease Control determined that senior living communities (also known as Long Term Care facilities) are now in priority group 1A, meaning we will be among the first in the nation to have access to the vaccine.

This very important news, along with our relationship with CVS/Omnicare, means that Spectrum residents and team members will be among the first in the nation to have access to the COVID-19 vaccine.

We will be providing additional information and important details as they become available, but we felt it important that you are aware of recent developments and the work we have been doing. It is our privilege and honor to be entrusted with the care of each of our residents during this worldwide pandemic.
